

- Youngest City in the UK and by some measures the youngest in Europe.
- Most ethnically diverse city outside of London.
- 13 major languages spoken here.
- First legislation for both free comprehensive education, and free school dinners.
- Independent Labour Party formed here in 1893
- UNESCO City of Film & Saltaire World Heritage Site
- Home of the Brontë sisters, David Hockney, JB Priestly plus Zayn Malik and Dynamo (BD25 Ambassadors




Barriers to UK Volunteering

- **Cultural** & Organisational Issues
- Time, financial costs (transport/childcare), physical accessibility, rigid role structures, and **Intimidating recruitment** are key deterrents
- For groups like asylum seekers, legal uncertainties and scheduling conflicts create specific barriers
- Remote volunteering is on the rise, increasing access for people with mobility issues, caring duties, and those in remote areas
- Micro- and skills-based opportunities add flexibility and relevance, appealing to diverse volunteers including corporate participants.
- **Community-based strategies** (e.g., Bradford 2025) recruit via word-of-mouth through local cultural groups

Demand for volunteering roles has risen steadily since 2004 with the occasional spikes and dips in interest during disasters, global economic situations and the pandemic.

Bradford 2025 calls out for culture year volunteers




Bradford 2025 volunteers will have travel and food expenses covered
