What's the need?

Poverty

- It is predicted by 2023/2024 the number of children living in poverty in the UK will reach 4.3 million

Mental Health

- In the last 3 years, children's emergency mental health service referrals have risen by over 50%.

Trio of Vulnerabilities

- 2.2 million young people in England are subjected to the effects of the 'Trio of Vulnerabilities' on family life: domestic abuse, parental drug/alcohol dependency, and severe parental mental health issues. This equates to six children in the average classroom growing up at risk due to their family circumstances.

Caring Responsibilities

-There are an estimated one million Young Carers across the UK looking after a family member with a disability, illness or mental health problem - some as young as five years old.

- Go Beyond provides Residential breaks for children aged 8-13 years at centres in Cornwall and Derbyshire.
- Referrals are made by teachers, social workers or care professionals who identify children living in difficult or challenging circumstances that would benefit most from a Go Beyond Break.
- At Go Beyond we believe that all children should be able to thrive whatever their home circumstances. No child should be defined by inequality, tragedy or instability.
